### Making Food Purchases





- If you do not use your SNAP benefits for 12 consecutive months, some or all of your benefits may be removed from your account for nonuse

# What if I do not want use all of my SNAP benefits in one month?



- For SNAP benefits, the benefits stay in your account until you use them
- If you do not use your SNAP benefits for 12 consecutive months, some or all of your benefits may be removed from your account for nonuse
- Once the benefits have been removed from your account for non-use, you CANNOT get them back

### Can Someone Else Shop For Me (SNAP)?



If you have added an Authorized Representative on your SNAP case, that person may purchase food for you using the EBT card and PIN that were issued to them.

They do not need your EBT card or need to know your PIN to make purchases. Their card gives them access to your benefits.

- The cashier may fill out a paper form called a SNAP benefit voucher
- The cashier will write in your number Kansas EBT Card number and the amount you are spending
- Do NOT give the cashier your PIN
- The Cashier will call the Retailer Customer Service number to see if you have enough benefits in your SNAP account to buy the food



• If there is enough in your SNAP account, you will be asked to sign the voucher and you will be given a copy of the voucher



- If there is enough in your SNAP account, you will be asked to sign the voucher and you will be given a copy of the voucher
- Keep the copy of the voucher, so you can subtract what you spent from the balance shown on your last EBT receipt

## How do I take something back to the store? Can I get cash back?



YOU WILL NOT GET CASH BACK. Take the item, receipt, and your card back to the store. The store will issue a credit to your appropriate benefit account (SNAP or Cash), which will be available to you immediately.

# Use your Kansas EBT Card at an Automated Teller Machine (ATM)

### Can Someone Else Shop For Me (Cash Benefits)?



If you have added a Alternate Payee onto your TANF (cash) case, that person may shop for you using the EBT card and PIN that were issued to them.

They do not need your EBT card or need to know your PIN to make purchases. Their card gives them access to your benefits.

#### •ATM

- -Cash withdrawals \$1.00 each
- -Other ATM surcharges from the ATM owner may apply. Kansas does not regulate individual ATM policy
- -If you do not want to pay the surcharge, cancel the transaction and go to another machine

#### **Using Your Child Care Benefits**



 If you qualify for child care benefits, your Kansas EBT card, can be used to pay a provider who is properly registered



 Funds for child care are deposited on the first of every month
